FIRST LOOK-PRESCHOOL: *SUNDAYS, 9:30 AM OR 11:00 AM*

The job descriptions and expectations for preschool and Elementary volunteers are as follows:

- **Small Group Leader:** Weekly commitment of being there physically and mentally. Engage the children, learn about what they are about and what they love. Show them you care for them and are interested in them. Connect with the parents.
- **Welcome Team:** Weekly commitment. Welcome all children and parents/adults. Help guests with check-in system and walk them to their classrooms.
- **Large Group Leader:** Weekly commitment. Welcome, excite and engage the children as they begin their worship time. Lead worship and music time through video presentation.

Youth Ministry Job Descriptions

MIDDLE SCHOOL & HIGH SCHOOL:
SUNDAY SCHOOL, 9:30AM - 10:30AM,
OR SUNDAY NIGHTS, 5:30 PM – 7:30 PM

The job descriptions and expectations for student ministry volunteers are as follows:

- **Small Group Leader:** Weekly commitment. SGL's are individuals who have a heart and desire to help our youth grow in the love of Christ. They love and care for our students and help them to apply the truths they will learn to their everyday lives through facilitating the discussion time. Small groups will be broken down by grade and gender. The leaders will be the same gender of the small group they are leading.
- **Welcome Team:** Weekly or monthly commitment. The responsibility of the Welcome Team will be to greet each youth and adult when they arrive and help them to check in. They will also be responsible for escorting the youth upstairs and connecting them with their SGL as well as introducing any visitors to the youth and SGL's.
- **Tech Team:** Our Tech Team will help with worship by assisting the worship leader with sound set-up, running the slides for music, scripture and the message. This team can include youth and adults. This team can serve on a monthly basis depending on the number of volunteers on the team.
- **Meal Team:** Our Meal Team will help to cook meals for the youth on Sunday evenings. Meals are an act of love and hospitality and helps promote fellowship and community building among our students.
